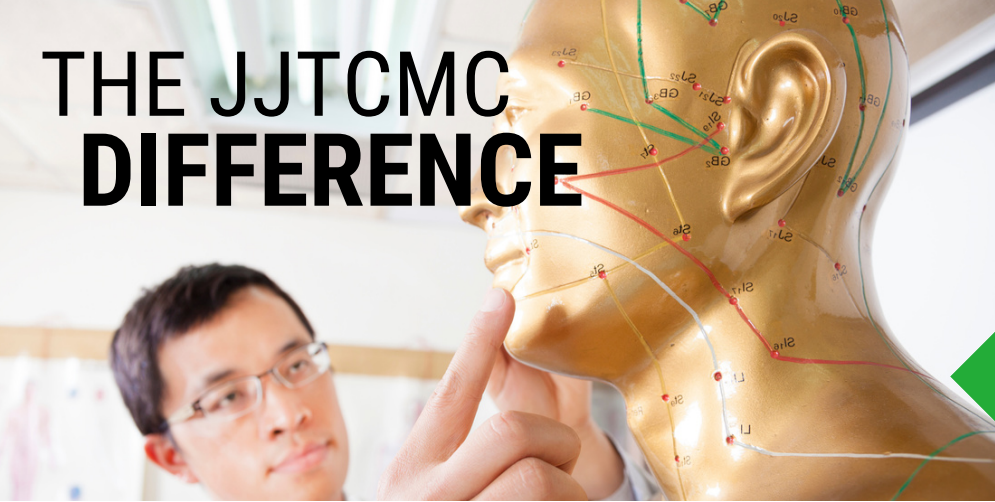

During clinical practice, we guarantee that students will gain exposure to an extensive range of illnesses, for example:

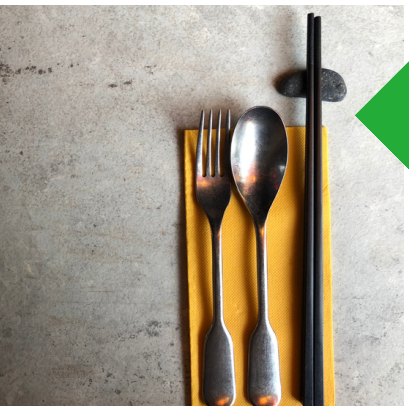

He has more than 30 years of experience in clinical practice, teaching and research in China and Canada. He is immensely adored and respected by his patients and students for his passion and sense of responsibility for the development of Traditional Chinese Medicine.

He developed the unique Acupuncture and Chinese Medicine Combined Target Treatment method for the treatment of tumors and cancers. His research was funded by the highest scientific funding association in China - The Chinese National Science Foundation.

John acts as a guest professor, teaching classical TCM literature for Nanjing University of Chinese Medicine. In addition to publishing more than sixty articles in peer-reviewed research journals on the topic of Acupuncture and Chinese Medicine, he has also contributed to many books on the subject.
